HOLIDAY WRAP RECYCLING

During holidays, there is much more paper recycling than other times of the year.

Please remember the following:

- Tape on wrapping paper is acceptable.
- Tissue wrapping paper is acceptable.
- Foil wrapping paper is NOT recyclable.
- Ribbons and bows are not recyclable, but they are reusable!



CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

Before setting your tree out on your curb for recycling pick-up:

- Cut trees into three-feet by three-feet sections
- Remove all decorations and tinsel
- Remove tree stand (*especially if it is drilled inside the trunk*)
- Flocked trees are acceptable

RECYCLE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

What is household hazardous waste? They are products that are useful around the house, such as paints, cleaners, and batteries, but need to be disposed of properly so they do not pollute our environment. These items are used daily by many people, who have them in the garage and under the sink and are illegal to place in the trash!

What are some examples of household hazardous waste?

- Batteries (*all types, disposable, car, rechargeable*)
- Cleaning chemicals & household cleaning products
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Motor oil and oil filters
- Paints and solvents
- Pesticides
- Sharps



The County of Santa Clara Household Hazardous Waste Program offers FREE appointments for residents to properly dispose of these products. To schedule an appointment at the San Martin collection facility, go to www.HHW.org or call (408) 299-7300. Up to 15 gallons or 125 pounds are accepted per appointment.

RECYCLE ELECTRONIC WASTE

The County of Santa Clara Household Hazardous Waste Program now offers free electronic waste recycling! This is a new convenient way to properly recycle electronic waste while you are dropping off unwanted hazardous waste.

Examples of electronic waste:

- Computer monitors & laptops
- Televisions
- Copiers
- Stereo equipment
- Telephones
- Calculators & more!
