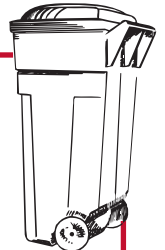

Put glass food jars & beverage bottles, plastic containers through ♻️, metal food and beverage containers, and scrap metal **all mixed together** in your recycling cart or bin.

GLASS

All glass food jars and beverage bottles such as wine, mayonnaise, and spaghetti sauce jars. Remove metal lids and place separately in bin.



METAL

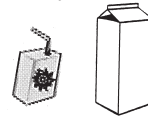
All metal food and beverage containers, including those made of aluminum, tin, steel, and bi-metal such as soda, pet food, soup, and tuna cans. (Lids okay and must be empty) Pots, pans, toasters, metal items, etc. must fit in bin.

Unacceptable Metal: Microwaves, car parts, small pieces such as nuts, bolts, and hangers.



ASEPTIC CONTAINERS

Aseptic containers include milk cartons and juice boxes.



PLASTICS

Plastics coded ♻️ through ♻️. Examples include: Clear, opaque, or colored containers including milk jugs, water bottles, shampoo bottles, yogurt cups, margarine tubs, polystyrene blocks, polystyrene packing peanuts (must be in secured or tied clear plastic bag), polystyrene and plastic "take-out" containers. Acceptable plastic bags are: grocery, produce, dry cleaning and newspapers bags. **Unacceptable:** Other plastics with no recycle code.



HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES: Put AAA - D batteries in zippered plastic bag on or next to recycle containers. No 9V or car batteries.

Please empty food and beverage containers.

Corrugated cardboard should be flattened, 3 ft. by 3 ft. in dimension and set next to recycling cart or bin.

MIXED PAPER

Example of acceptable paper:

- Newspaper
- White & Colored Paper
- Envelopes
- Cereal Boxes (remove liners)
- Cracker Boxes

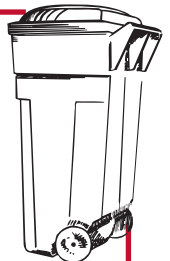


- Magazines

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD



Please flatten, and no larger than 3 ft. by 3 ft.

Place grass clippings, leaves, small branches, and food scraps in your green composting cart. (yard waste cart)

COMPOSTING CART (Food & Yard Waste)

Place grass clippings, leaves, small branches, food scraps, bones, food soiled paper and pizza boxes in your green yard waste cart. Lid must be closed. Excess yard waste can be placed in regular 32 gallon garbage cans or tied in bundles. Bundles should be no larger than 3' x 3' and placed next to your cart. You may place up to 7 additional containers or bundles out for pick-up.

Note: Our trucks can pick up yard waste containers weighing up to 150 pounds.

Examples of Unacceptable items

- No rock, dirt, concrete, ashes, asphalt or building materials
- No ice plants, palm fronds, cactus, poison ivy, poison oak, or bug, moth or ant-infested material
- No garbage.
- No Liquids
- No Hazardous Waste
- No Yard Waste will be collected in plastic bags.

FOOD
WASTE
ADDED

Hints for collecting food scraps in your kitchen:

Use washable container with lid, such as a large yogurt tub or large coffee can. Call 842-3358 to request a container.

USED MOTOR OIL

Place used motor oil next to your recycling bin in one-gallon plastic containers with tight-fitting screwtop lids. Call 842-3358 to request free oil recycling containers. You may place up to **three one-gallon containers** for pickup next to your recycling bins on your regularly scheduled collection day.



USED OIL FILTERS

Put used oil filters (fully drained) in sealed, leak-proof plastic bags and place curbside next to your recycling bin. Call 842-3358 to request free oil filter bags.

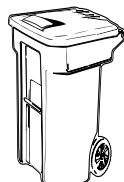
